This is a great opportunity for you to learn about all the jobs it takes to make this event a success. Key Workers will be on hand to answer questions. # MEMC(METRO-EAST MARCHING CLASSIC) 2024 WORK SHIFT DESCRIPTIONS

LOCATION: OTHS SMILEY STADIUM & GROUNDS

DETAILS: The MEMC is a marching band competition held at OTHS. The event will begin at 11:00 and we will host 24 bands. The OTHS Marching Panthers will perform twice for exhibition. The given times are approximate for all shifts and updates may be made based on the final registrations. Parents, please wear your yellow spirit band shirts and report to the "volunteer/information" tent to sign-in just inside the gates of the stadium. Please plan on getting to the stadium 20 minutes before your shift to allow for parking and check in. Please park as far off campus as possible.

INFORMATION BOOTH & SIGN-IN: This position requires sitting and possibly some walking around the grounds.

Must know basic knowledge of how MEMC is run

All volunteers must check-in at this booth and get your MEMC NAME TAG

Position assists volunteers with check-in, issue name badges, and confirms attendance on volunteer list.

Directs volunteers to work location and name of area key worker.

Alerts Co-Chairs if a specific area is short volunteers and if extra volunteers are available.

WEBER GREETER & ESCORT: This is a mostly seated position

Must be a friendly personality and have a general idea of how MEMC is run.

Greet bands in the Weber Field area and answer any questions from volunteers & guest bands/parents/directors. You will need to hand out information packets to the band directors as they arrive.

TICKET SALES: North & South Entrances This job is a seated job and will not require standing

Sit at tables in either the north or south entrance areas, greet all patrons, take money, sell programs, and provide wristbands. This will require taking cash and using a POS handheld device.

GATE GUARD: This is a position that requires standing for your shift

Greet patrons and check to make sure all that are entering have a wristband. Direct patrons to the bleachers and let them know that they can also go to the other end of the bleachers to enter if the area is too congested.

PROGRAM SALES: This position requires standing and walking

Selling programs inside the entrance of the stadium. Encourage all patrons to purchase a program. You can also walk around the entrance/bleachers/concession stand areas.

BLEACHER ACCESS CROWD CONTROL (1 PERSON NORTH & 1 PERSON SOUTH): This position requires walking and standing

BUT you get to see ALL the bands @

Control one-way traffic of spectators at entrances and exits. Keep spectators from entering stands during band performances.

**BAND ACCESS MONITOR:** Assist bands in entering. Direct entering spectators/patrons to the main entrance gate. This ENTRANCE & EXIT is for BANDS ONLY!

PRACTICE FIELD MONITORS (2 PEOPLE PER A & B FIELDS): In this position the volunteer will sit at a table and use a timer to keep bands on schedule and must be authoritative.

Keep visiting bands on time in moving to and from the practice fields east of the Weber parking lot.

HOSPITALITY ASSISTANCE: This position is very active around the stadium.

Provide snacks in multiple areas throughout the day for judges, press box, and directors.

<u>CONCESSIONS & BAND WAGON</u>: This is a very active and busy area that involves a lot of stocking and supplying of food and drink. Grillers- Grills what is needed by the key worker

Concession North- Main area – primary duties=taking orders, fulfilling orders, cash handling. Runners may need to run food items to south & visitor areas.

Concession South- Far end of the field- duties are the same as above.

Concession Visitors Side – Visiting side of the field with a limited menu.

Band Wagon - Take orders, fulfill orders, cash handling, and use POS device. Items include funnel cakes, fried Oreos and nachos.

HYDRATION STATION: This position is busy especially when bands are finishing.

Volunteers will hand out water to the performers as the bands exit the field after competing.

**CROSSING GUARDS:** This position will require you to be on your feet for much of the shift. You can bring a chair for times when traffic is slow or there is a break.

Safely cross patrons and bands across the street from the Weber parking lot to the stadium.

**BOUTIQUE:** This is a seated position where you will sell merchandise and accept cash and credit.

MEDICAL: This position will aid any band or patrons that need medical assistance.

If you are in the medical field, we would love to have help in this area. You will provide medical attention at any time during the event to participants and visitors.

FLOATERS: This position could be a mix of any of the above

This could be odd jobs or working at an area that may be busier than others depending on timing of the event.
